I. CALL TO ORDER

A. Certification of Public Notice.

Mayor Gonzalez called the meeting to order and certified the public notice of the meeting as properly posted Friday, October 18, 2024.

B. Roll Call.

Norma A. Cantu, City Secretary, called the roll noting the absence of Commissioner Kerr and Mayor Pro Tem Farias and quorum present.

II. PUBLIC COMMENTS

None.

III. NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Pro Tem Farias arrived.

A. Discussion and consideration to exercise the one-year extension option with Pavement Markings for Weslaco Pavement Marking Improvements and authorize the Mayor to execute any related documents. Possible action. (Staffed by Public Works Department.)

David Arce, Public Works Director, requested approval to exercise the first extension of a three single year option with Pavement Markings from Donna; agreement was approved September 2023 for one-year with the extension renewal options; vendor agreed to honor the same pricing of the original agreement. Staff recommended approval.

Commissioner Lopez seconded by Commissioner Pedraza moved to approve a one-year extension with Pavement Markings as presented. The motion carried unanimously; Mayor Gonzalez was present and voting.

B. Discussion and consideration to enter into an agreement with the developer of Chelsea Park Subdivision for road improvements on a section of West 10th Street and authorize the Mayor to execute any related documents. Possible action. (Staffed by Public Works Department.)

David Arce stated the developer is paving in his development Chelsea Park Subdivision located on 10th and Border Ave.; approximately 170 feet of asphalt of the existing roadway is in need of an overlay; developer offered to overlay the additional section at no charge for labor and equipment if the city considered to pay for the two loads needed of asphalt (approximately 50 tons @ \$86/ton = \$4,300); staff noted the developer is required to remove the current curb on the north side of the road and widen the street by approximately three (3) feet as part of the subdivision process. Staff recommended approval.

Commissioner Pedraza seconded by Commissioner Lopez moved to approve an agreement with the developer of Chelsea Park Subdivision for road improvements on a section of West 10th Street as presented. The motion carried unanimously; Mayor Gonzalez was present and voting.

VII. ADJOURNMENT

Commissioner Pedraza seconded by Commissioner Rodriguez moved to adjourn the special meeting of October 21, 2024, at 5:37 p.m. The motion carried unanimously; Mayor Gonzalez was present and voting.
